Kankakee Area Career Center Supply List

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY

- Appropriate shoes/boots and clothing; i.e., work pants or blue jeans (NO SHORTS or Nylon Pajama Pants) Baggy clothes will not be permitted.
- Safety glasses (the first pair is provided by KACC)
- Pocket flashlight
- Pencil/Pen
- Binder with loose-leaf paper
- Auto I: Class fee is \$30 (includes the cost of Auto Tech Shirt, tread-depth gauge, tire-pressure gauge, and tool pouch)
- Auto II: Class fee \$20-(T-shirt-Safety Goggles)

Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) Training Program

- Pens/Pencils

- Clothing: white uniform pants, navy blue scrub top, white tie shoes, name tag (purchased through KACC)

- Watch (with a sweeping second hand needed before the first day of clinical rotation)
- A two-step TB test and Influenza vaccine are offered on-site at KACC through the Kankakee County Health Department or may be done separately through the local health department, family physician, or occupational health department at the student's expense.
- Hepatitis B vaccine (recommended, but not mandatory) at student's expense
- Fingerprint Background Check performed at KACC, a drug screen may be a requirement of the medical facility in which clinical hours are earned.
- Covid vaccine is highly recommended, if not vaccinated medical facility at the clinical site may require weekly testing.
- Class Fee is due and payable to Kankakee Area Career Center within the first week of school. The fee per year is \$155. The fee covers the cost of a skills bag, CPR Card, IDPH required fingerprint/background check, picture ID badge, and textbook.
- After successful completion of KACC's and State IDPH requirements, C.N.A. Training program, students will be eligible to sit for the CNA State Exam. The estimated fee is \$75. The fee is at the student's expense and will be paid directly to the testing site.

- Channel Lock or Vice Grip style pliers (1st-year students)
- MIG Pliers (2nd-year students)
- Tungsten (2nd-year students only)
 - 2-3 pcs. 1/16" Rare Earth or purple-tipped
 - 1 pkg 3/32" Rare Earth or purple-tipped
- Chipping hammer
- Wire brush
